Sri Vasireddy Vidya Sagar, Chairman of the Governing Body & Social Educational Trust chaired the meeting and initiated the Proceedings with a warm welcome to all governing body Members to the 6th governing body meeting (Autonomous).

Dr M V Raghu Ram, Dean of Freshman, Placement and Training welcomed the Governing Body members Dr. KVSG Murali Krishna, Prof, Civil Dept & DAP, JNTUK, Kakinada , Member, State Govt.(APSCE) Nominee, Dr. K. Meera Saheb, Prof, Mechanical Dept, JNTUK, member, JNTUK Nominee, Industrial Experts, Educationalists and other members of the Governing Body.

Dr Y Mallikarjuna Reddy, principal of the college welcomed all the honourable members and presented the agenda items of the meeting for consideration, approval and suggestions from all the members of the Governing Body. He presented the Academic Report for the AY 2022-23.

The following items of the agenda were discussed and the resolutions were passed unanimously by the Governing Body.

Resolutions

Item -1:

Approval of the minutes of 7th Academic Council meeting held on 11-10-23.

Resolution-1:

The Governing Body resolved to ratify the minutes of the Academic Council Meetings held on 11-10-2023 with necessary instructions for effective implementation in Toto. The Governing Body welcomed the additional intake in B.Tech-AI&ML.

Item -2: To approve increase in intake in B. Tech-CSE programme from 240 to 480, addition of new course B. Tech- CSE (AI) with 180 intake and merger of the B. Tech course Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIM) with 180 into B. Tech-CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) (CSM) with 180 for total intake of 360 from AY 2024-25.

Discussion: Dr Y Mallikarjuna Reddy, Principal has informed the members that VVIT has become the autonomous college, permanently affiliated to JNTUK with one of the largest sanctioned intake of students by AICTE for the AY 2023-24. As per the AICTE and UGC guidelines, the college can increase in intake in the existing B. Tech CSE programme from 240 to 480. In addition, a request for a new UG programme in CSE (AI) with 180 intake has been proposed. Also, he informed all members that the existing UG programme in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIM) be merged with the existing B. Tech course in CSE Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (CSM) from AY 2024-25 for academic convenience.

Resolution-2:

The GB approved the application process of increasing the intake in B. Tech CSE programme, request for a new B. tech programme in CSE (AI) and merger of B. Tech programmes AIM with CSM.

Items 3: To approve R23 Regulations and First year Course structure for all B.Tech programmes offered by the college from AY 2024-25.

Discussion: Dr Y Mallikarjuna Reddy, Principal has informed that the R23 Curriculum and Coursework regarding First year of B. Tech Programmes in all branches has been designed as per the advice of Dr KVSG Murali Krishna, Director of Academic Planning, JNTUK. He further said that APSCHE, JNTUK and AICTE guidelines were followed in this regard.

Resolution-3: The GB approved the R23 Regulations, curriculum and course structure for all I B. Tech programmes offered by the college from AY 2024-25.


Item -4: To approve MoUs signed with RWTH Aachen University, Germany and Purdue University, USA.

Discussion: Dr K Giri Babu, Dean of Academics informed the members of the Governing Body that VVIT has began the process of signing MoUs with two foreign Universities and that there is a good response from both of them. Dr William Oakes, representing Purdue University, Indiana, USA has appreciated the Community Service projects of VVIT students and has initiated the MoU process under EPICS, a service-learning design program in which teams of students partner with local and global community organizations to address human, community, and environmental needs. He further informed that, VVIT has met the representatives of RWTH Aachen University, Germany and agreed to enter into an MoU for enhancing international cooperation in academic and employment.

Resolution-4: Members of the GB expressed their interest in international academic cooperation by giving their consent to the proposed MoU and encouraged the institute to plan more such initiatives that are necessary for the transformation into a university of repute.

The meeting ended with a formal vote of Thanks by the Dean, Dr. MV Raghuram with an assurance to implement the suggestions made by the Governing Body.
