Dr Vedantam Ramachandran Bhat, Professor and Head, Department of CSE welcomed the members to the 8thAcademic Council meeting held as an Autonomous institution.

Dr. Y. Mallikarjuna Reddy, Principal welcomed the JNTUK Nominees, Directors, Deans, Heads of Departments and other Academic Council members and presented the agenda for the meeting. He expressed his happiness about the sanction of increased intake from 240 to 480 seats for UG programme B.Tech -CSE, additional UG programme B.Tech -CSE(AI) – 180 seats and merging of B. Tech-AI&ML (AIM) programme into B. Tech-CSE(AI&ML) (CSM) – 360 seats by AICTE with effect from AY 2024-25. The total intake in all UG programmes has been increased to 2160 (36 sections). He appraised the members of the ongoing construction and building development activities on campus like the new instructional areas, boys and girls hostels in line with the increased academic infrastructure requirement.

He also informed that the CSE, EEE and Mechanical Depts. have been accredited by NBA under Tier 1 status for 3 years from the academic year 2023 to 2026.

Dr K Giri Babu, Dean of Academics presented a gist of R&D projects, Patents, Faculty Publications and FDP activities for the AY 2023-24. He shared the details of student internships, with and without stipend with the council. He further informed that VVIT complied with the APSCHE and JNTUK norms for skilling students and faculty on the EdX platform.

The following items of the agenda were discussed and the resolutions were passed unanimously by the Academic Council.

Item No. 6: To present the placement status and upcoming training for the AY 2024-25

Dr U Madhaviah, Training and Placement Officer informed that student data is shared with companies and some placement drives are in pipeline. He also presented the placement, internship and higher education statistics to the esteemed members of the Academic Council. He informed them that TPC implements a comprehensive 4-fold training programme right from the first year of B. Tech to train and assist students to get industry certified on in-demand employability skills to provide them better placements. He informed that On-site stipend-based student internships has been the priority ever since internships were made mandatory in the final semester for B. Tech students. He further informed the Academic Council that placement process is on going despite being slow in progress and results from the major recruiters is awaited.

Discussions: Dr B Bala Krishna, Director Evaluation, JNTUK congratulated the Exam Cell and Controller of Examinations for successfully accomplishing the task. As the results of the 2020-24 batch students were approved by the Results Committee and the process of conferring degree to the students can be initiated. He enquired about the variations if any in the college Academic Calendar.

Dr Venkat Reddy, Director of Academic Planning, JNTUK appreciated VVIT for its academic growth and the increased intake. He suggested that the college Academic Calendar may be synchronized with that of JNTUK as advised by APSCHE for facilitating better planning of student internships in semester breaks, summer, and final semesters. He also encouraged the college to provide internships at the location of the industry rather than in online mode. He further expressed his hopefulness that all the EdX registered learners will successfully complete their certification in time and students with additional certifications would be preferred by their potential employers. Also he informed that all students must be encouraged to do their internship in APSCHE listed companies. In case any potential company identified by institute, offers significant internships, it can be added to APSHCE, by raising a request. He advised the students to choose courses that are outside their academics based on their interest.

Dr Gopala Krishna, university nominee concurred with the ideas expressed by the Director of Evaluation and DAP, JNTUK. He suggested that a list of FDPs organized by the institution with details of duration and the FDPs attended by faculty outside the institution with details and duration may be presented. He observed the need for categorizing the patents into two groups as Design Patents and Utility Patents. He also suggested that Department wise statistics on Student Salary Packages and the information regarding innovative ideas from students and faculty be included in the presentation. He congratulated the Institute on its academic growth.

The Academic Council gave the approval to conduct Graduation Day and wished the graduating students success in their lives.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the HoD, CSE expressing gratitude on behalf of the Students, Staff and Management of VVIT for their valuable suggestions given by the university members with a promise to follow and implement them diligently.
